NCC UDAIPUR TRIP

ONE OF THE KEY HIGHLIGHTS OF THE EXPEDITION WAS THE NCC TRAINING SESSIONS, WHERE THE CADETS WERE INTRODUCED TO ESSENTIAL ASPECTS OF MILITARY-STYLE TRAINING. UNDER PROPER SUPERVISION AND GUIDANCE, THEY LEARNED ABOUT RIFLE HANDLING, SAFETY PROCEDURES AND BASIC DRILL PRACTICES. THE EXPERIENCE HELPED THEM UNDERSTAND THE IMPORTANCE OF DISCIPLINE, ALERTNESS, COORDINATION AND RESPONSIBILITY WHILE HANDLING TRAINING EQUIPMENT.

THE CADETS ALSO PARTICIPATED IN ACTIVITIES DESIGNED TO STRENGTHEN THEIR PHYSICAL FITNESS, TEAMWORK AND LEADERSHIP SKILLS. WORKING TOGETHER AND FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS AS A TEAM TAUGHT THEM THE VALUE OF COORDINATION AND MUTUAL TRUST. BEYOND THE TRAINING, THE TRIP ALSO ALLOWED THE STUDENTS TO DISCOVER THE HISTORY, CULTURE AND BEAUTY OF UDAIPUR. CAREER COUNSELLING SEMINAR

IN AN ERA WHERE TECHNOLOGY IS TRANSFORMING THE WAY WE LEARN, WORK AND INNOVATE, OUR SCHOOL ORGANISED AN ENGAGING CAREER COUNSELLING SEMINAR FOCUSED ON THE RAPIDLY EVOLVING WORLD OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES. THE SESSION CONDUCTED BY THE MULTIMEDIA CLUB INTRODUCED STUDENTS TO THE GROWING OPPORTUNITIES IN FIELDS SUCH AS ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE, MACHINE LEARNING, DATA SCIENCE, ROBOTICS, CYBERSECURITY, SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT AND OTHER TECHNOLOGY-DRIVEN CAREERS. THE SPEAKERS FROM IBIRDS SOFTWARE SERVICES DISCUSSED HOW AI IS RESHAPING INDUSTRIES AND HIGHLIGHTED THE IMPORTANCE OF DEVELOPING SKILLS THAT GO BEYOND ACADEMIC KNOWLEDGE. STUDENTS OF CLASSES IX TO XII WERE ENCOURAGED TO DEVELOP CURIOSITY, CREATIVITY, PROBLEM-SOLVING ABILITIES, COMMUNICATION SKILLS AND ADAPTABILITY TO PREPARE THEMSELVES FOR THE CAREERS OF TOMORROW.

AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE SESSION WAS UNDERSTANDING THAT AI IS NOT SIMPLY A CAREER OPTION—IT IS ALSO BECOMING A PART OF ALMOST EVERY FIELD, FROM HEALTHCARE AND EDUCATION TO ENGINEERING, FINANCE, DESIGN, MEDIA AND BUSINESS.

STUDENTS ALSO GAINED VALUABLE INSIGHTS INTO CAREER PATHWAYS, HIGHER EDUCATION OPTIONS, SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND THE CHANGING DEMANDS OF THE JOB MARKET. THE INTERACTIVE SESSION GAVE THEM AN OPPORTUNITY TO ASK QUESTIONS AND GAIN A CLEARER UNDERSTANDING OF HOW THEY CAN PREPARE FOR THE RAPIDLY CHANGING PROFESSIONAL LANDSCAPE.

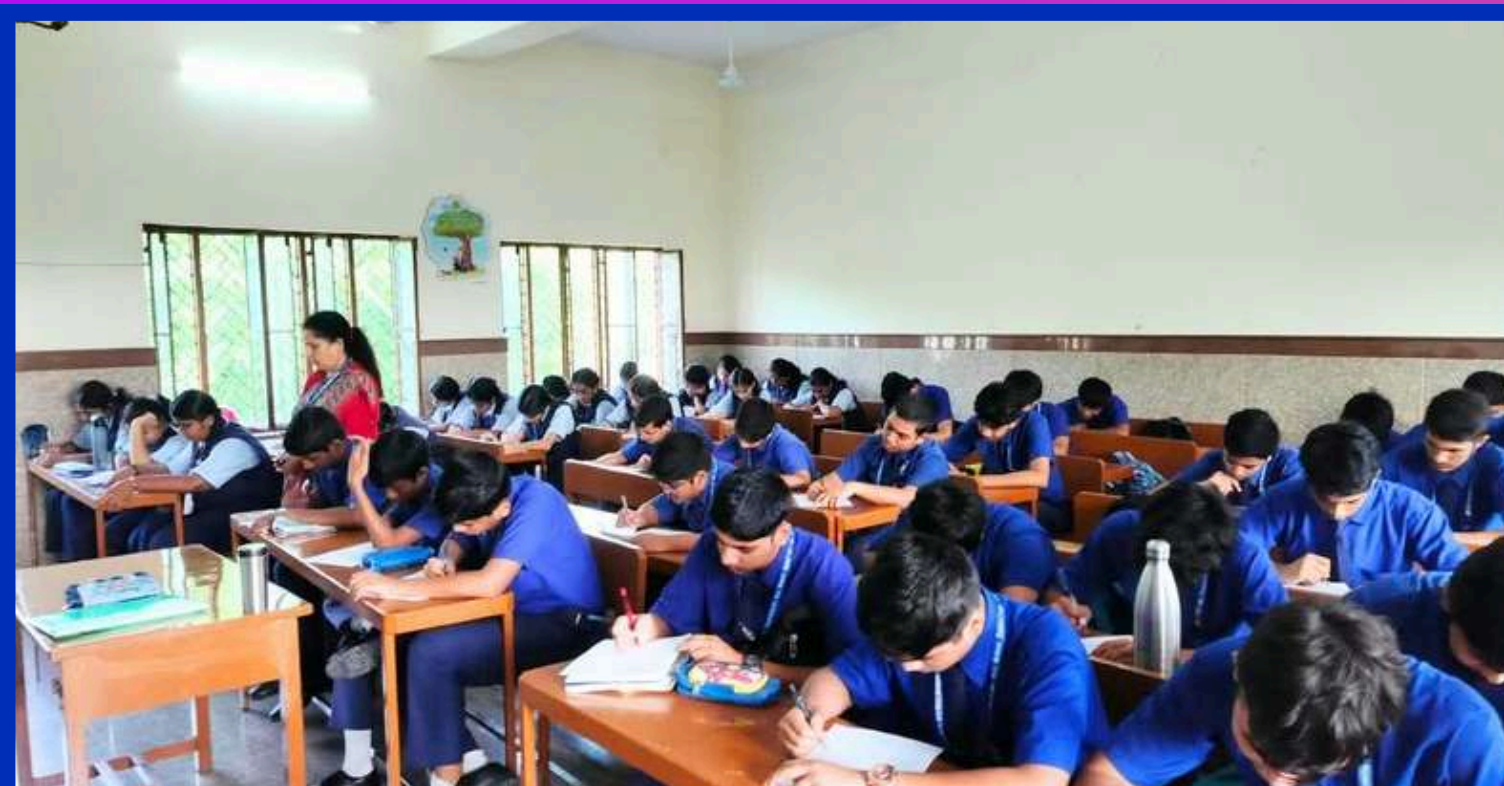

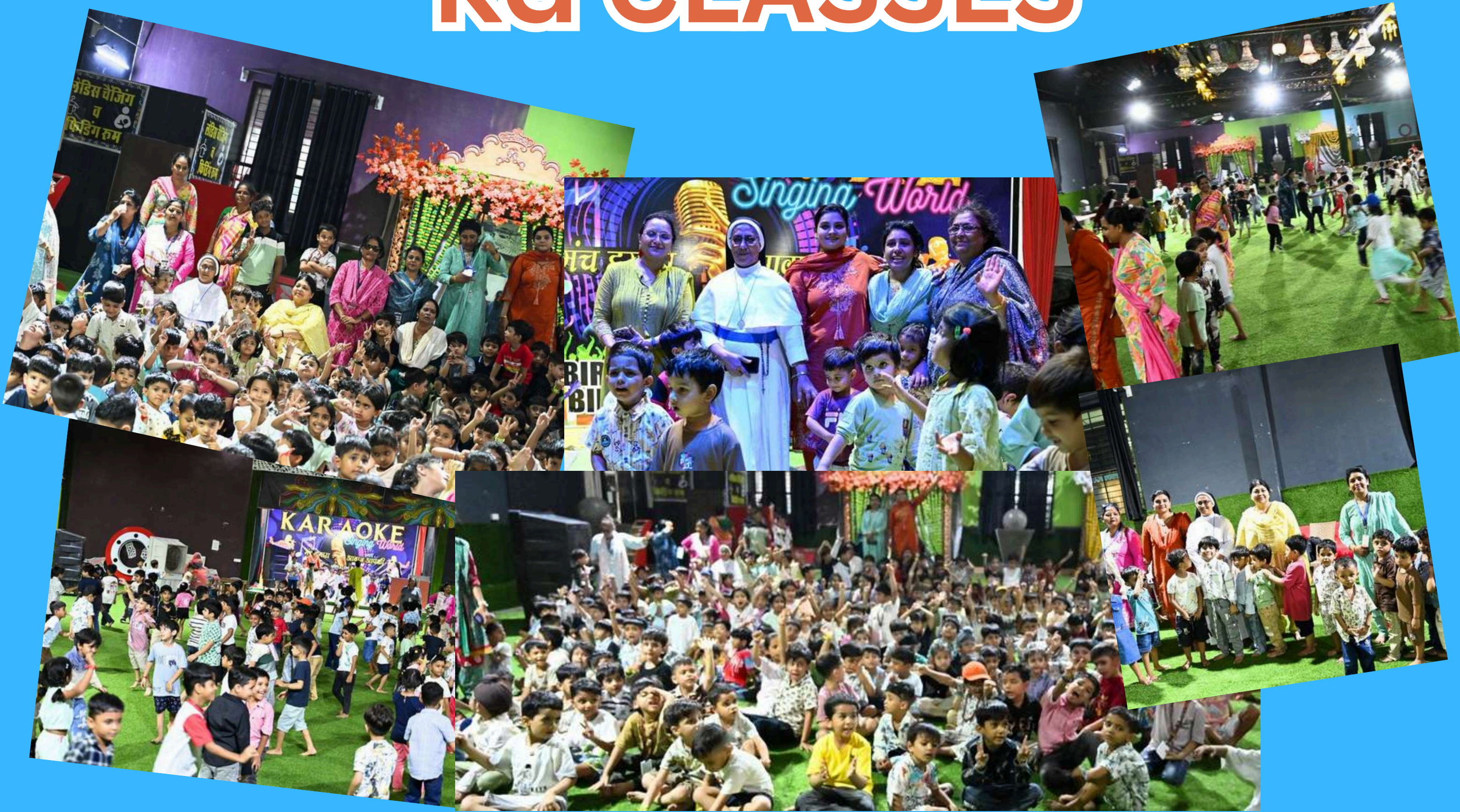
ART WORKSHOP – CLASSES III TO V
